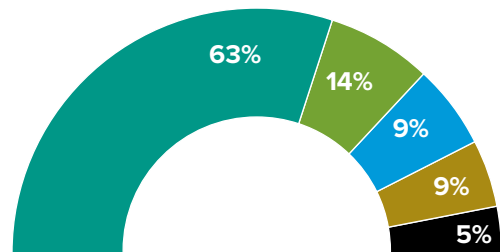
# BioOne Complete: An Investment in Sustainable Scholarly Communications

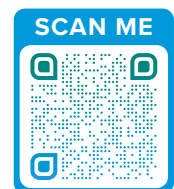
