# Appendix 3 - Cutting and drying pasture quadrants for estimating pasture availability 

1. Make a 25 cm square quadrant out of timber, weldmesh or other suitable material.
2. Place the quadrant on a representative section of pasture.
3. Cut the pasture in the quadrant close to the ground and avoid collecting dirt.
4. Weigh the pasture sample using kitchen scales (e.g. 500 g ).


Sub-sampling to get a sample size small enough top dry.
