APPENDIX A

Glossary

(after Needham & Keirans, unpublished)

Adanal plates: paired ventral plates bordering the median and anal plates in male *Ixodes*.

- Alloscutum: that portion of the female and immature ixodid dorsum posterior to the scutum.
- Anal groove: semicircular groove curving around the anus in some genera of Ixodidae, curving anterior to the anus in *Ixodes* but curving posteriorly or absent in other genera.
- Anal plate: single posteromedian plate surrounding the anus in male *Ixodes*.
- Anus: posterior opening of the alimentary tract, situated ventrally on the median line posterior to the last pair of legs.
- Auricula(e): paired ventral extensions at the sides of the basis capituli of some *Ixodes* species; they may be flattened ridges, mild protuberances, or prominent, retrograde, and hornlike.
- Basis capituli: basal portion of capitulum to which the mouthparts are attached.
- Capitulum: in Ixodidae, the anterior movable portion of the body,
