Annotated Bibliography of Helminths of Waterfowl, by Malcolm E. McDonald. Special Scientific Report — Wildlife No. 125. Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife, Washington, D.C. June 1969 - 333 pp.

"This bibliography is an attempt to list all of the publications dealing with helminths of waterfowl (Anatidae) - reports of their occurrence, descriptions, classification, life history, and pathological effects. It brings up-to-date and revises the work published on microfilm in 1965 (Wildlife Disease, No. 45). Studies on prophylaxis and treatment and on physiology, and general manuals and texts on poultry diseases are omitted. Publications issued before 1890 (numbering about 120) are also omitted, as the information in many of these is incomplete and the identifications dubious." - from the preface.

A general bibliography of over 1450 references, covering the period 1535 through 1968; including 69 references on parasites and diseases, 18 on nutrition, 10 on osteology, 29 on physiology, 54 on reproduction, and 13 on anatomy.
